






Today, we are blessed with 15 men preparing themselves for a life of priestly service. It is essential to fund this vital ministry, which operates at an annual cost of \$50,000 for each seminarian.

Currently, the education of Seminarians is funded through several sources. These include the Annual Catholic Appeal, various grants and donations received by the diocese, the annual Easter collection, and diocesan subsidies. Through the *United in Faith* Campaign, the diocese will invest \$5,000,000 in an endowment to be used for the education of




Parish Sharing/ Parish Growth & Development


The *United in Faith* campaign will infuse much-needed funds into our local parishes, enabling capital projects and ministry support. Parishes may utilize these campaign funds in the way that best benefits the parish.

The campaign target for each parish will include the 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal. This will allow focus on the *United in Faith* campaign while continuing the pastoral and charitable outreach that is funded annually by the Appeal.

- Once a parish surpasses its 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal goal, 50% of the funds collected up to its United in Faith target will return to the parish.
- If a parish exceeds its *United in Faith* target, it will then receive 75% of the funds collected

Parishes may utilize *United in Faith* campaign funds in the way that best benefits the parish. Examples include:

- Expanding or renovating church facilities
- Creating a new parish ministry or strengthening existing ministries
- Establishing or increasing endowments to generate income for:
 - Parish maintenance
 - Pastoral ministries, programs and outreach
 - School tuition assistance
- Reducing parish debt
- Hiring personnel or increasing resources for:
 - Adult Faith Formation
 - Youth Faith Formation
 - Outreach to the poor, needy and vulnerable



















Priest Retirement

\$3,000,000

AS OUR DIOCESAN PRIESTS AGE AND RETIRE, THEY ARE DESERVING OF OUR SUPPORT.



There are 23 priests currently receiving retirement benefits in the Diocese of Memphis, and 14 currently active diocesan priests will be eligible to retire within the next 10 years. The Diocese of Memphis continuously reviews our clergy's pension and retirement needs regarding the cost of living increases, medical care, living arrangements, etc., to ensure we are providing benefits that allow them to retire with dignity and grace.

Therefore, the Diocese of Memphis will establish an endowment to provide additional funding to help offset increased and/or unforeseen expenses in the care of our cherished retired priests. We must continue to provide opportunities to engage, encourage and strengthen the relationship the younger members of our Catholic Faith have with our Lord and the communities in which they thrive.

The Diocese of Memphis will establish an endowment that will provide grants to parish youth/college/young adult ministry programs. This will allow parishes to enhance existing programs and to explore new and creative ways to engage the youth, college-aged and young adults of their parish and the diocese.

Permanent Diaconate Endowment

\$500,000

THE ROLE OUR DEACONS FILL IN OUR PARISHES HAS GROWN TREMENDOUSLY, SERVING AN INTEGRAL PART IN OUR SPIRITUAL AND SACRAMENTAL LIVES. Currently, the Diocese of Memphis has 55 active deacons and 41 men enrolled in the diaconate formation program. The need for ordained deacons has never been more prevalent, especially within our growing Hispanic communities.

All permanent diaconate candidates are currently responsible for funding their own studies throughout this 5-year program, with an average cost of \$20,000 out of pocket. All too often, cost is a deterrent to a candidate's moving forward in formation. The United in Faith Campaign will establish an endowment to provide grants and scholarships to qualified candidates to aid in their education.

The deacon is described as "the Bishop's ear, mouth, heart and soul."

The deacon is at the disposal of the bishop in order that he may serve the whole people of God and take care of the sick and the poor; he is correctly and rightly called "the one who shows love for orphans, for the devout and for the widowed, one who is fervent in spirit, one who shows love for what is good."


GIFTS OF PROPERTY, LIFE INSURANCE , WILLS OR BEQUESTS
